## About Us

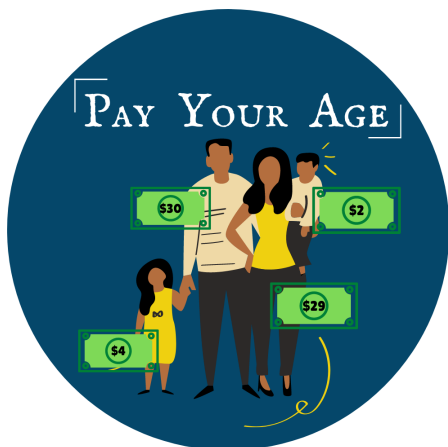
